### Summary of Key Decisions:

Decision ref	Key Decisions
1	Agreed that Group membership needs widening to ensure maximum clinical engagement & input. Noted that membership should include a spread of geographical areas & medical disciplines
2	Agreed for NWL not to deploy Asthma watch list onto live Dashboard until development is complete on additional functionality
3	Agreed to proceed with addition of EFI to Dashboards, but that Q-Admissions licensing cost is too high to merit inclusion. NWL will scope creation of local risk-stratification algorithm instead
4	Agreed to display care plan flags for Diabetes & Dementia in the Dashboard
5	Agreed that proposed Social Care visualisation is acceptable for deployment
6	Agreed that questions on ACP Dashboard development are outside scope of this Group
7	Agreed to request quote on change to GP data query, to include data on acute care referrals
8	On patient profile, phrasing "care plan" is too vague – needs to be made clear that this is a GP care plan
9	Agreed that Dashboards do not need rebranding at this stage
10	Agreed to begin to integrate Learning Disability data into Dashboard
