Summary of Key Decisions:

Decision ref	Key Decisions
1	Suggested to possibly combine the COPD and Asthma LTC radars into a single radar
2	Agreed that only the date of most recent Social Care review is needed to be added to current data specification
3	Agreed that Social Care data on reviews should also include patients without currently open activity
4	Agreed that, as part of scoping for CCG-specific partitioning of Dashboards, NWL will need to consider possible future implications (e.g. for future provider access across CCG boundaries)
5	Noted that any risk-stratification measure included in the Dashboards needs not to exclude LTC management if focusing on measurement of frailty. Agreed that, for all risk-stratification measures, would be desirable to be able to drill-down to individual measures & causes
6	Suggestion for a frailty/multi-morbidity radar to be added to the development backlog
7	Noted that the WSIC Dashboards programme has expanded to include multiple workstreams
8	Agreed that the following development items are prioritised by the Clinical Advisory Group for inclusion in the next release <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fix to Care Plan Impact Graph on ACP Dashboard • Outcome measures from Hillingdon ACP Dashboard • (Deprioritise work on consolidated table per CCG/ACP) • ETL enhancement for 18s-& 65-year-olds • CTV3 to ReadCodeV2 mapping
