Summary of Key Decisions:

Decision ref	Key Decisions
1	Agreed that patient-level diabetes radar can be released to Live in current form.
2	Agreed that patient level diabetes radar does not need print functionality
3	Agreed that a patient-facing view of the Dashboards would be useful in the long-term
4	Agreed that data trend lines on diabetes radar should go as far back as is possible without an adverse effect on performance
5	Suggested to create two separate views for diabetes radar –an administrative view where the RAG-rating is based on completion of the 9 key care processes, and a clinical view where the RAG-rating is based on the numerical values of the care processes. It was agreed that this was not a priority for Release 8 of the Dashboards
6	Agreed that the Social Care visualisation needs to show all 10 care categories (even if only some of the categories apply)
7	Agreed to deploy the Social Care visualisation if a sufficient proportion of care is appropriately categorised
8	Agreed to prioritise scoping of the COPD radar, load of Hillingdon A&E data, and ACP Dashboard related work for Release 8
9	Agreed that community data via SystmOne should be the next area of data prioritised for loading and we should review the Community data specification to understand whether this could be 'enriched' through using direct community data flows.
