Summary of Key Decisions:

Decision ref	Key Decisions
1	Suggested to include a measure of 'functional status' on patient-level COPD radar. Acknowledged that this measure is not always well-captured, and does not have a specific read code
2	Suggested that the COPD radar have separate pages for health indicators vs. lifestyle indicators, to avoid overloading the visualisation
3	Suggested that anxiety would be a useful co-morbidity to monitor on the COPD radar
4	Develop approach to pilot Diabetes radar to EMIS practices and to provide Tony with access to Richford Gate data and to put on hold deployment of the Diabetes dashboard to Hounslow and H&F until data anomalies are resolved
5	Explore how the NWL Diabetes Transformation Programme can support the deployment of the Diabetes radar is deployed
6	Agreed to send out a communication to affected practices regarding the data anomalies found in GP data for Hammersmith & Fulham and Hounslow
7	Agreed that development priorities for Release 9 of the Dashboards are to be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scoping of addition of medications to the Diabetes radar • Scoping Mental Health data to the Diabetes radar • Restricting Patient Search functionality for Secondary Care users to only the appropriate CCG.
