Summary of Key Decisions:

Decision ref	Key Decisions
1	Agreed to avoid mini-releases where possible, given the effect on development time & server availability. This will be dependent on scope of requested changes & clinical priority
2	Agreed to expand primary care representation of other CCGs on Multi-morbidity Radar scoping panel.
3	Noted that development of functionality to flag specific patient cohorts will need to include ability to remove flags in De-Identified Dataset after a given period
4	Agreed that the following items would be prioritised for development in Release 13: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Multi-morbidity Radar • Changes to patient segment to allow users to select over 65s cohort • Building ETL to allow for flagging of bespoke patient cohorts • Data Warehouse changes to prepare for SNOMED coding • New column on Asthma Radar to show patients prescribed LABAs without an ICS • Scoping of a combined view of patient-level Diabetes Radar (completion and clinical assessment of value) • Scoping of changes to patient type mapping • Incorporate the new networks for H&F within the data warehouse
5	Agreed that a process needs to be established whereby changes to LTC radars need to be discussed with the specific clinical lead ahead of CAG.
6	Agreed not to change eFI categories to match the clinical systems – need to scope size of effect & proposed change
7	Agreed to include eFI category filter in Multimorbidity Radar, with ability to filter by all 4 eFI categories, not just Moderate or Severe frailty as initially proposed
8	Agreed need to clarify how future changes to externally-developed Dashboards will be funded
9	Agreed to proceed with WSCI/CIE single sign-on (SSO) integration
