1	<p>Agreed that there is a strong case for integration of children's Social Care data into the Dashboards.</p> <p>Recommended for NWL to raise this at the next Governance Group meeting.</p> <p>Noted that this may need to include safeguarding flags, which are currently removed from the Dashboards as sensitive data and also build the case for the inclusion of children's social care data into WSIC.</p>
2	<p>The following items were prioritised for release 11:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Addressing QOF LTC age discrepancies • Design of under 18s population sub- segmentation • Upgrading Data Warehouse to prepare for SNOMED coding • MDT referral flag (specifically for MCMW) • Scoping change of Activity Timeline data from SLAM to SUS • Change to Hillingdon Hospital data specification, to allow for flags for patients in a care home or referred to a CCT
3	<p>The following items were suggested for addition to the development backlog, for prioritisation in a future release:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Age filter on Asthma Radar (and on Dashboards in general) • Early Years Dashboard (suggested to use Mitch Blair, Imperial Paediatrics Professor, as Clinical Lead and for Bob Klaver to explore work underway in Scotland in this area)
4	<p>Agreed to explore the possibility of giving practices access to the new Population Health views</p>
5	<p>Agreed that changes to IG regulations (PIA, GDPR) will enable further work on reviewing opt-out codes used in WSIC</p>

6	Agreed to proceed with sharing of a patient level WSIC record in CIE, while noted that IP issues will need to be considered.
7	Agreed to proceed with creation of advisory group for the Population Health workstream
