Decision ref	Key Decisions
1	Agreed not to change Diabetes Radar from rolling 15-month period, to financial YTD, to match QOF
2	Agreed to take proposed roadmap of future datasets to IG Governing Group for sign-off rather than take a document for each dataset
3	Agreed to implement proposed changes to RFC process
4	Suggested to edit new RFC form to ask more specific questions about expected benefit of proposed change
5	Noted that non-clinical data feeds (e.g. Local Authority data) can be of equal importance as clinical data feeds
6	Agreed that desired refresh schedule for forthcoming new Dashboards should be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Weekly for patient-level dashboards ○ Monthly for aggregated (Population Health) dashboards
7	Suggested to set up separate 'publications panel' to discuss & update on studies & publications based on WSIC data
